General Information

- 1) Questions relate to activities for the period from: **July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011**
- 2) Where documentation is requested, copies of same must be attached or points will be disqualified for the particular question
- 3) Deadline date for return of the Award Form must be complied with to avoid disqualification.
- 4) The PA Council Association Award (trophy) will be awarded to the Association with the Best comprehensive program and a Certificate will be awarded to the Association with the next best comprehensive program based on the three areas mentioned above.
- 5) A member can only be counted once for any specific activity. For example, if a member presents a seminar, the member cannot also be considered as having attended that same seminar.
- 6) Under section I, count each activity or program under each question. (i.e. if you co-sponsored four (4) courses, take credit for four (4); if you offered two (2) scholarships, take credit for two (2), etc.)
- 7) Under Section II, count each activity for each member. If a member attended two (2) courses, count each course; if a member attended ten (10) seminars or workshops, count all ten (10).
- 8) Under Section II, all questions related to **non-job responsibilities** – **participation on panels and awards received which are not part of or gained from your employment responsibilities.**
